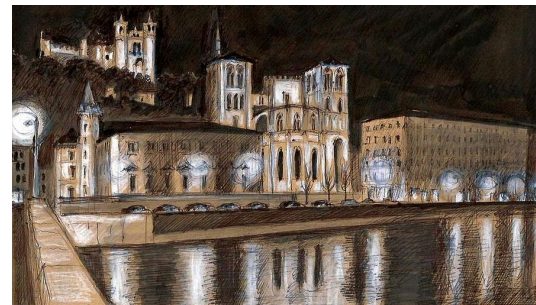

# French course programs

## 1. Integration into international groups (if the students are 16 years old minimum)

Programs of 20 or 26 lessons/week in groups of 14 international students max.

Students are integrated into existing groups corresponding to their level for the duration of their program.

Programs recommended for groups with mixed levels or for groups with less than 12 participants.



## 2. French programs tailored to the group

Programs from 15 to 30 lessons/week in closed groups (from 10 to 19 students).

The students are distributed according to their level in different closed groups of 10 to 19 people according to the requests made in advance.

Tailor-made program, great adaptation of content according to educational needs.





# French course programs

## PEDAGOGY

- Educational material created and personalized by teachers, according to the level and objectives of the group, based on communication and practice.
- An evaluation system before the arrival of the student (written test) and during the program to see the progress of the participants.
- A level certificate expected at the end of the program.

# Accommodation options

## HOST FAMILY

Single or double room, shared bathroom or with the host family.

Arrival on Sunday, departure on Saturday.

- 2 meals (breakfast and dinner).
- 3 meals (full board \*) \*Picnic or hot meal in a canteen for lunch.

- ❖ The perfect option to share the daily life of a French family while experiencing life in France in an authentic way.
- ❖ The families are chosen both for their professionalism and for their desire to meet and exchange with foreigners.
- ❖ A very large number of our host families live near the school (walking distance or at most 30 minutes by public transport).



# Accommodation options

## RESIDENCE / HOTEL

For 18+ people.

Single or double room with  
Small kitchen in hotel residences only.

Arrival on Sunday, departure on Saturday.

- ❖ Average travel time to school: 15 to 30 minutes on foot or by public transport.
- ❖ The hotels and hotel residences are located in recent and modern buildings.
- ❖ Recommended option for accompanying persons who wish their group to be accommodated in the same building.
- ❖ Hotels and hotel residences selected and regularly checked.

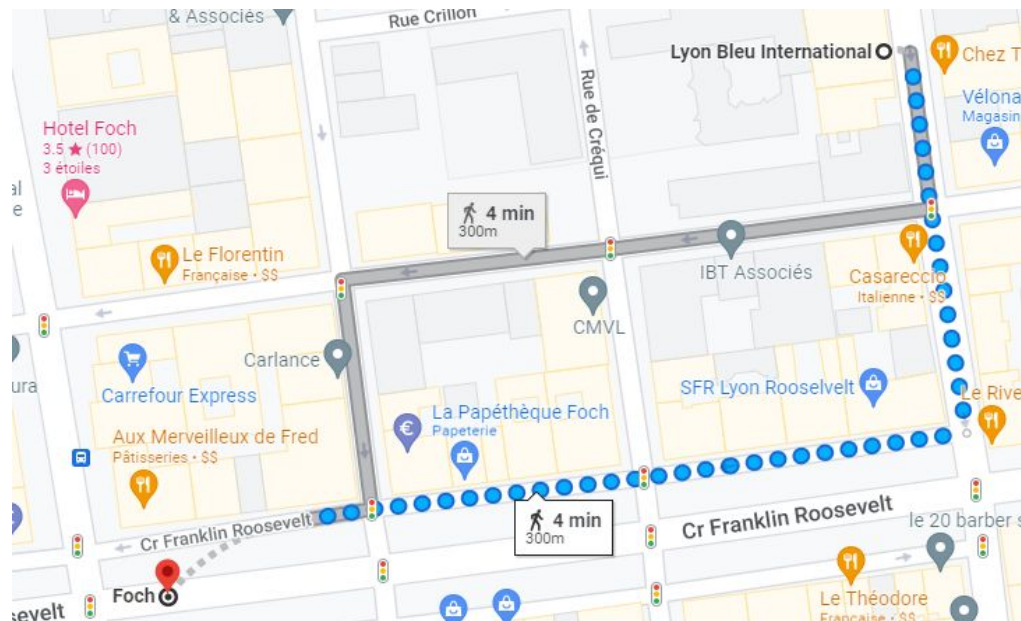
